Speech is what makes us human, and free speech is fundamental to our democratic citizenship, our dignity and our freedom. It is through free expression that we protect and claim our other rights.

If we cannot speak out, we cannot demand the right to life and health, and we cannot protect against attacks on us and our rights.

We seek to build the widest possible coalition of organisations and individuals who care about the right to free expression.

## ▶ **OUR AIMS**

- To monitor the free flow of ideas and information and report on relevant events and developments in the SADC region.
- To inject an informed, principled, consistent, and fact-based freedom of expression position into the national discourse.
- To encourage awareness of freedom of expression across all elements of society, ensuring it is not just a media concern but one for all citizens and civil society.
- Facilitate alliances and partnerships with like-minded organizations, local and international.
- Undertake strategic and precedent-setting legal action to defend free expression.
- Act as a think tank on policy, particularly around digital media, disinformation and regulation.

- Principled support for maximum freedom of expression and open and informed debate, argument, disagreement and the free flow of information.
- Non-partisan support for the expression of all opinions and ideas, no matter how uncomfortable, controversial and unpopular.

## ► PROGRAMMES

### Dark Days in eSwatini

**T**he Campaign for Free Expression's (CFE) special report on recent developments in eSwatini, *Dark Days in eSwatini*, highlights the monarchy's harsh response to protest and its tight control over how it was reported.



## Hate Speech Bill

**C**FE is concerned at the move to criminalise hate speech in the draft Prevention of Hate Crimes and Hate Speech Bill in South Africa, and has made representations to Parliament to improve the Bill before it is passed into law.

## Companies Amendment Bill

**T**he new Companies Bill promises some powerful steps forward in bringing greater transparency to the South African corporate world.

It will require companies to identify who earns the most in their organisations, who earns the least, and what they earn.

And it will oblige them to compare their highest-earning 5% of staff, the lowest 5%, and the median.

It will compel companies to identify their beneficial (hidden) owners, which should provide an important weapon against money laundering and tax evasion. CFE will push to ensure that the progressive elements of this Bill are not rolled back.

## ▶ OTHER ACTIVITIES

We are planning to tackle:

- Online threats and attacks, particularly against women, that are designed to intimidate and silence
- Internet regulation which could enhance or limit our freedom of speech
